Misstatements on Aid to Sandino Answered

Replying to statements reported to have been made by U. S. Minister to Nicaragua Eberhardt, and General Logan Feland, commander of U. S. marines in Nicaragua, to the effect that first aid equipment being sent to the Sandino forces by American workers, Manuel Gomez, secretary of the All-American Anti-Imperialist League yesterday issued the following statement:

"The story appearing in this morning's New York Times under a Managua date line is merely another indication that the United States' government and its representatives wish to do everything possible to prevent even first aid equipment from reaching the Nicaraguan liberation forces

under General Sandino. Like the im-
muration of Senator Gillet made a
few weeks ago, the present imma-
turation proves no proof. When Sena-
tor Gillet made his statement, we
challenged him to prove what he said
—whereupon the worthy senator dis-
appeared into silence. We give him same
challenge now.

"The All-American Anti-Imperialist
League (U. S. Section) is cooperating
in this country with the campaign
being carried on in all countries of
North Central and South America
under the general auspices of the
Hague-Hil-Mannaguan Committee to
raise funds for bandages and medical
supplies for Sandino's wounded. We
are prepared to produce a receipt for
shipment of medical supplies. This
receipt is signed by Doctor Franklin
Turner, general representative of
General Sandino.

"The purpose of such charges as
have now emanated from the marine
politely department of Mannaguan is
to hinder our campaign to raise funds
and thus prevent the sending of
further supplies from this country."
